She is also one of the founders and directors of the Non-Profit Organisation called Love, This Skin which aims to end the stigma of albinism in South Africa by challenging misconceptions and beliefs, educating the public and highlighting empowering stories about people with albinism.

Paul visits each of the thirty businesses on our programme on a monthly basis. Each of these businesses are required to complete a micro-business course at our centre with Karen Ross, our Sustainable Livelihoods Manager, and then to submit their business plans to her.

Once admitted they are supported financially on a loan/grant scheme, as well as with mentorship and workshops for a period of at least a year.
